
Office Farmers






22' Challenge Theme Climate Action: Practicing Net Zero


Encourage hackers utilize (open) data to raise Generate/Analyze/Prototype types of solutions for cities to practice Net Zero.

- City-based actions toward net-zero GHG emissions can facilitate the introduction of technological and industrial transformation





- √ 1 bunk bed for free for 30 nights; Free co-working space for 30 days; Per diem for each team member to cover living expenses for 30 days;

- ✓ Consulting services: Legal, financial, taxation, and market-development.




