In 2001, Research Center on International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health and Assistive Technology (RICFAT) of National Yang-Ming University was entrusted by Ministry of Interior (now the Social and Family Affairs Administration, Ministry of Health and Welfare) to establish the Center for Assistive Technology Resources and Popularization (CATR@P). For 16 years, CATR@P has served as a national platform for managing and promoting assistive devices, services, and resources. In other words, it is the only national unit established by the central government to manage and promote assistive devices and resources.

Along with professional curating organization, Chan Chao International Co., Ltd., RCFAT co-hosted ATLife 2017, Assistive Technology for Life from July 21 to 24, 2017. The grand exhibition proved to be a huge success. It now currently stands as the only professional exhibition of assistive devices and healthcare in Taiwan, receiving widespread recognition from across domestic and foreign industries and the general public, particularly those in need. In 2017, 176 exhibitors attended the exhibition using 500 booths, attracting a visitor count of over 53,000 people. It drew the attention of businesses in related fields, government departments, and the industries of assistive devices and long-term care. This further connects assistive device industries to Taiwan's central and local governments for enhancing the management of assistive devices, services and resources. It joint businesses from related industries to join in expanding the market and preparing people for the upcoming era of national long-term care.

Main exhibition area



Walk Around

Mobility aids (sticks/walkers/manual wheelchairs/motorized wheelchairs/electronic scooters), welfare vehicles and components for modification, cushions, positioning systems for mobile assistive devices



Household Assistant

Eating, dressing, using objects, 3D printing life assistive devices, toilet, decompression mattress, bed, chair bed, repositioning aids, renovating old apartments, a new apartment for a new life.



Communication without Barriers

Auditory, visual, communication, and computer aids



Rehabilitation and Entertainment

Rehabilitation exercise facilities, interactive somatosensory rehabilitation systems, inclusive facilities, and toys and games



Smart Care Area

Automatic care devices, ICT/IoT care applications, and remote care.



Assistive (Medical) Device Stores Special Area

Assistive (medical) device store services and assistive device living center.



Respiratory Care Area

Respirators, oxygen machines, bulb syringes, blood oxygen monitors, sprayers, humidifiers, cough assist machines, sputum suction pumps, the vest airway clearance system, liquid oxygen, portable oxygen machines, and smart medical respiratory care.



Prosthetics and Orthopedic Area

Prosthetics, orthodontic (equipment), orthotic insoles, orthotic shoes, and 3D printing prosthetics (equipment)



New Materials and New Assistive Devices Area

New materials, new designs, and the application of new components.



Assistive Device Safety Inspection Verification Area

Various international assistive device standard safety inspection and verification services

Resources and services for assistive devices / long-term care

CATR@P, Social and Family Affairs Administration, and Ministry of Health and Welfare will cooperate with city/county assistive device resource centers and long-term care units to provide services including free assistive devices onsite, advice and suggestions for long-term care, introductions and subsidies for assistive devices, and opportunities to experience assistive devices.

Promotion of government policies / professional services

Central and local government departments (such as Ministry of Health and Welfare, Ministry of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Science and Technology, Ministry of Labor, and Ministry of Education), and professional societies and associations will be invited to provide exhibitors and visitors with government policies and professional services, and to exchange opinions.

Event Planning

Policy and Industry Forum

A policy and industry forum will be held to facilitate and promote exchanges from all walks of life. In addition, seminar rooms will be provided for different industries and professional services to promote and share their experiences.

Marketing Planning



Professionals and supervisors of assistive devices or service units

- Through diverse channels, we will strive to invite representatives from all levels of government and their entrusted service units, elderly care institutes and groups, physical and mental welfare institutions and groups, industry societies and unions, medical organizations, medical and long-term care professional guilds and associations, and social welfare foundations and groups to attend the exhibition and the educational activities and workshops.
- Invitation will be printed and mailed to domestic and foreign traders in related industries, dealers, manufacturers, people from related departments in colleges and universities, organizations, and groups to attend the exhibition to strengthen the effect of the exhibition.
- Co-organizers will cooperate to promote the event and increase the visibility of the exhibition and its peripheral activities.
- Information on the exhibition, related activities, and workshops will be posted on the exhibition's official website and on the Resource Portal of Assistive Technology website under the Social and Family Affairs administration, Ministry of Health and Welfare.
- The co-organizers' network community and the Resource Portal of Assistive Technology website will regularly send out over 30,000 e-DMs and will post links on affiliate websites to further spread the information about the exhibition to expand the effect of the promotion.



General Publics

- To promote this exhibition, strategic alliances will be formed with domestic hospitals, medical equipment stores, and assistive device stores to enlist their aid in sending out invitations and posting posters to increase the ways to promote this exhibition.
- The exhibition will be promoted through communication tools including e-newsletters, e-DMs, print media (such as newspapers and magazines), and electronic media (such as TV and the Internet). (For more details, please refer to the media promotion planning.)
- Groups will be invited to attend the exhibition and, with reservations, provided guided tours.



Print Media Promotion

- Advertising space will be purchased in domestic newspapers to post information about the exhibition.
- Professional media (such as newspapers or magazines) related to finance or health will be engaged to publish special reports on the assistive device exhibition.



Electronic Media Promotion

- A press conference will be held to promote the importance of this exhibition to the management of assistive device resources and long-term care.
- The exhibition will be promoted through TV commercials. In addition, one week before the exhibition, topics that will attract the media's attention will be found so as to promote the exhibition intensively and strategically to create an impression that the exhibition will be popular.
